# **DIRECTOR NOMINATION | INFORMATION PACK**

## Responsibilities of the Board of Directors

The Board of Directors governs Northside Community Forum Limited and has the overall responsibility for setting the strategic direction of the organisation.

All Board members are required to act in accordance with the Constitution, Northside Community Forum's Board Code of Conduct, and any other relevant policies, available on <a href="mailto:yourside.org.au">yourside.org.au</a>.

### **Election Process**

Election of directors will take place at the Annual General Meeting to be held on 21st October 2020.

Persons seeking election are required to provide their nomination to the Company Secretary by 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020 to enable candidate information to be distributed to members ahead of the AGM.

### Format of Nomination

### All nominations must include:

- a completed Nomination Form, with the signatures of two (2) nominators and the nominee
- a completed and signed Consent to Act as Director form
- a current high resolution 'passport style' photograph
- a current 1-page CV and;
- a candidate statement not exceeding 350 words. The candidate statement must provide details of the nominee's career history, reasons for nominating for the Board position, address any particular skills being sought by the Board, personal qualities and any relevant appointments or interests that would contribute to the Board. This statement should be suitable for providing to members in relation to the nomination.
