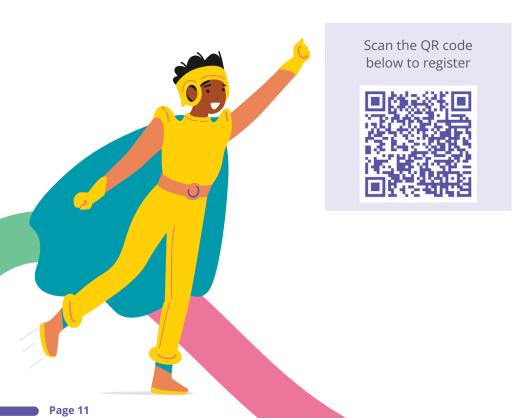

Caped Crusaders:

Information HQ

Tailored Support Packages are financial support from the government to support areas of your life your caring role may be impacting.

They can be used to fund:

Tutoring

To support you receiving weekly tutoring for up to four terms. Tutoring can assist you catching up with the class, revising and studying for exams.

Driving Lessons

We understand that with caring responsibilities it can be hard to find the time to practise driving. We can offer support with completing a portion of your logbook hours, helping you to gain confidence or polish up on the test requirements.

Respite

Respite care is when someone else takes care of the person you care for so that you can have a break. A break can give you time to do everyday activities, deal with stress, and look after yourself.

Counselling

The caring role can often impact emotional wellbeing and bring on stress, anxiety and increased pressure. We offer in-house counselling referrals for 16+ and external referrals and support links for our younger carers.

Mentoring and Coaching

This can assist young carers in working towards goal setting, employment or balancing their caring role. Mentoring services can guide young carers to set and achieve goals.

It Takes A Team:

Youth Mentoring for young carers

It Takes A Team Youth Mentoring program is based on best practice youth development principles and puts the young person in control of their mentoring experience. Our aim is to support young carers through all stages of their carer journey, to help them thrive and continue caring in a supported environment. Our strengths-based approach supports them at every stage, helping them thrive in their caring role. Through practical, non-clinical sessions, we guide them in setting and achieving goals, providing ongoing support both in person and online.

Depending on the needs and goals of the young carer, our mentoring program may include:

- ★ Goal identification and development,
- ★ Skills and strategies to balance personal goals with carer duties,
- ★ Academic support and skill-building sessions ,
- ★ Exposure to opportunities and support services,
- ★ Support to understand and overcome challenges of their caring role,
- ★ Resource provision, and
- ★ Community building activities.

Length of Sessions

Sessions are 1 - 1.5 hours each and usually spaced 2 weeks apart to ensure momentum and important time for reflection and implementation. Sessions can be held both in person and online. In-person sessions will be held in a public location accessible by public transport.

We will work with Your Side and the young carer (and their family if needed) to determine the best schedule for each young carer.
